- Why not? 😞
- **Enthusiasm** for the topic
- ThinkPads are still to be found in business and hacker circles
- also pop-culturally relevant
- Eventful history with lots of **trivia** and **curiosities**
 - Industrial design

 - 02:28:55 🙄

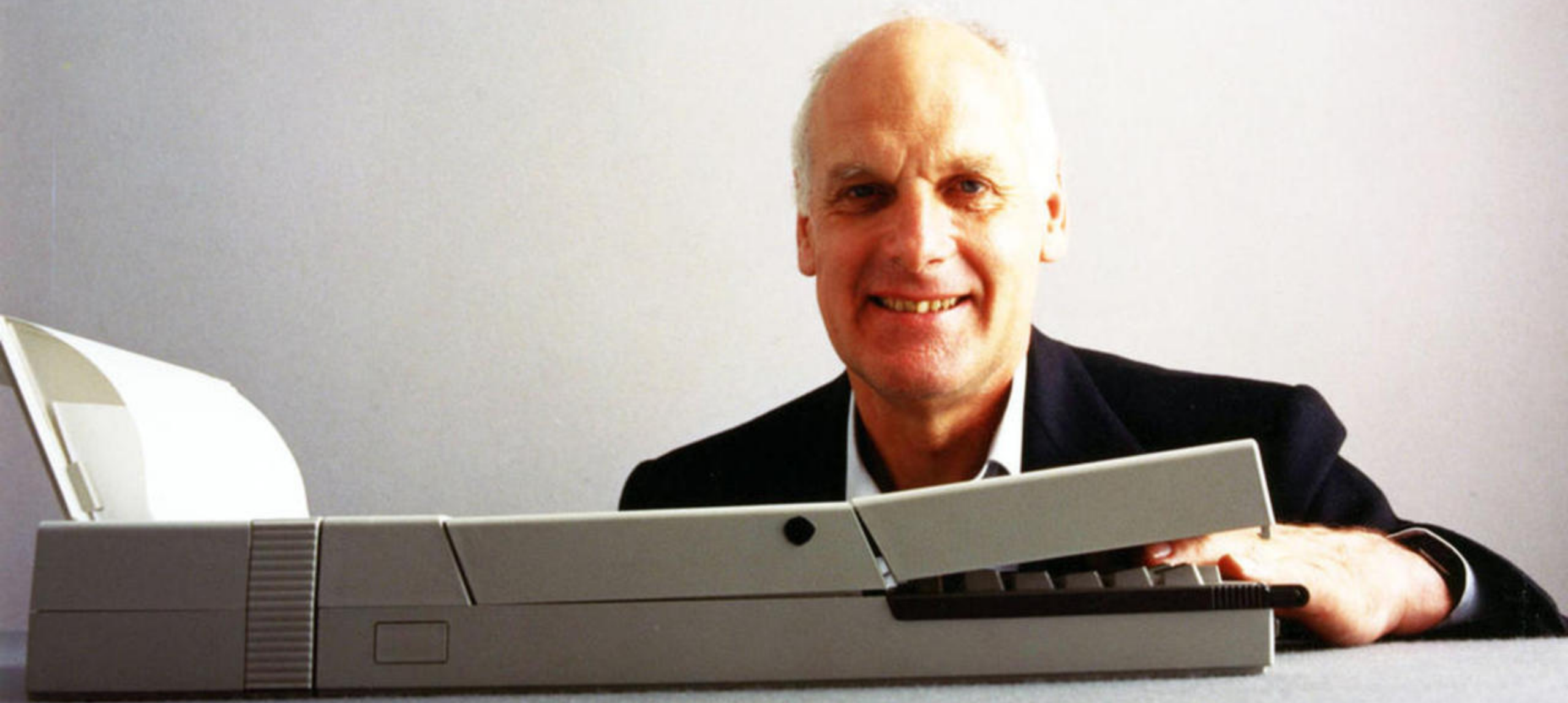


- have been produced since **1992**

 - PDAs (IBM WorkPad)
 - PowerPC and ARM notebooks
 - unusual expansion modules
 - Notebooks with **two displays**
- popular due to good **Linux** support, among other things

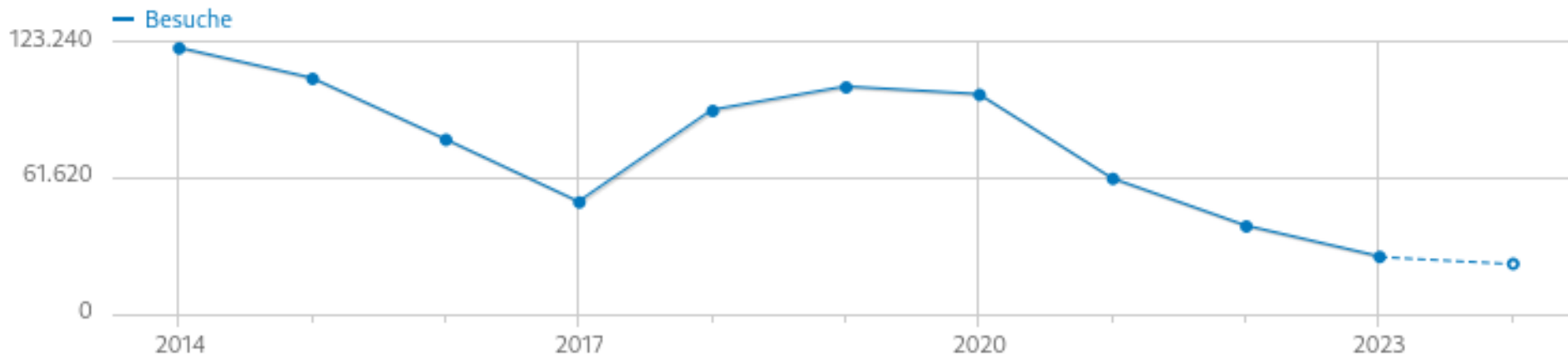

Why as podcast?

- People suffer from a decreasing **attention span***
 - Blogs are read less and **less often** (attentively)
- Video is too time-consuming, already exists
- I wanted to learn something **new**, I like listening to podcasts
 - **market analysis** has shown that there is no such thing yet
 - deliberately made in German, accepted smaller bubble

Planned formats

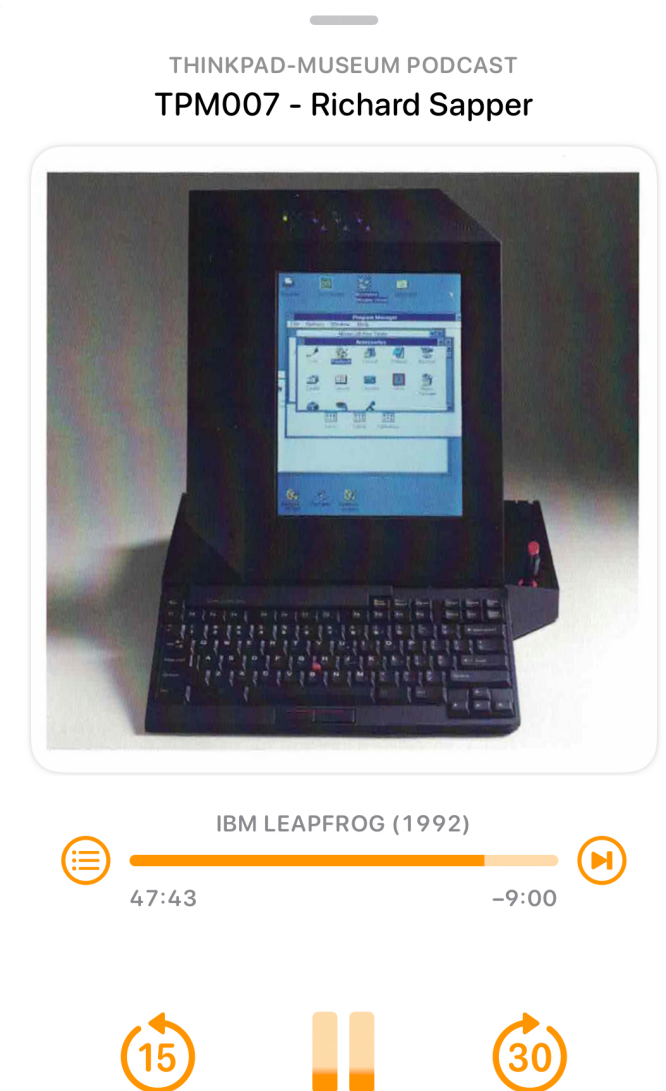
Variety important right from the start to get people excited:

- **History** - Historical context to IBM and co.
- **People** - designers, engineers, **community**
- **Model** - individual devices and series
- **Technology** - e.g. VGA, Windows 3.x



Technical wishes

- Chapter markers and show notes
 - should be self-evident
- **Audio-visual** medium
- Usefully supplement audio with **chapter images***
 - e.g. detailed shots of the devices
 - Consideration: Context must also be provided without images
- **Transcripts**
 - Accessibility and SEO

Branding

- ThinkPad Museum was obvious, ThinkPod already taken
- **TPM*** as episode prefix
- **Cover** with TrackPoint for direct association
- **Audio scheme**
 - Searched **catalogs** (e.g. [AudioJungle](#)) for hours
 - wanted an electronic scheme with iconic ThinkPad **sounds**
 - Musicians in my circle of friends created exactly that 😊

Work organization

- **Markdown** documents in **Git** repositories*
 - Repos for episodes, artwork, website
 - Lessons Learned: Git **LFS** for large images
- **Kanban board** and issues for episode planning
 - **Tags** for different topics
- **Two** Markdown documents per episode
 - Content keywords and chapters (`notes.md`)
 - Research notes and source collections (`dossier.md`)

Tools

- Focusrite **Scarlett Solo** Gen 3 + beyerdynamic **DT 797 PV**
 - something cheaper will do as well (e.g. RØDE NT-USB Mini)
 - I find headsets easier to use than stand mics
- [REAPER](#) and [UltraSchall](#)*, [Studio-Link](#) for guests
- Scheduling with [nuudel](#)
- [GIMP](#) for images and artwork
- [whisper.cpp](#) for transcripts
- Static website with [Hugo](#)
 - customized `hello-friend-ng` [theme](#)

Workflow

1. Topic selection (from backlog)
2. **Research** (Internet, books)
3. Recording
4. Editing and post-production
5. Chapter markers and **images**
6. Audio export
7. Create **transcript**

= ~**10h** per episode 🕒



CPU goes brrr 🔥

Editing and post-production

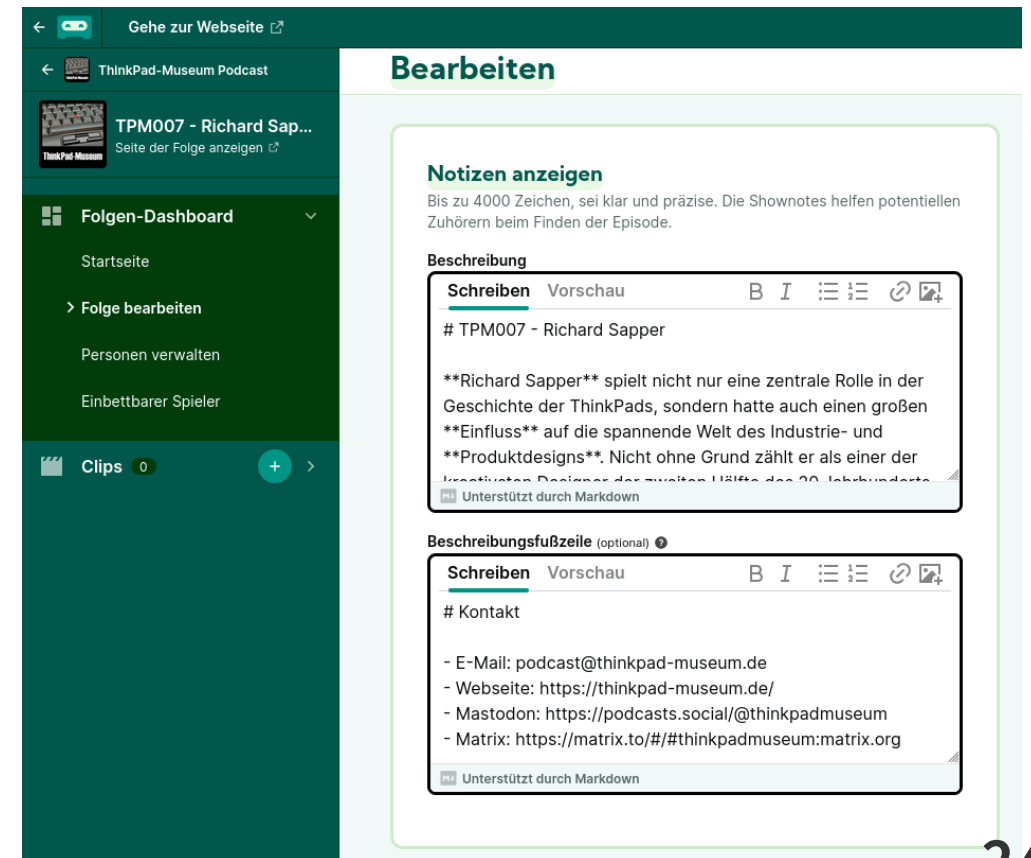
- Cut speech pauses and **spoilers**
- Remove background noise
- Normalize **-23 LUFS** voice tracks
- Activate per **voice track**
 - VST: ReaEQ (Cockos)
 - JS: Ultrasonic Dynamics
- JS: Activate LUFS Loudness Metering on **Mastertrack**
- Export with **Meta** information
 - Title, author, podcast, year, category and description

- There are numerous **services** for automated transcripts
 - Cost per minute/episode (or personal data)
- Running a museum is costly enough 😊
 - also friend of **self-hosting**
 - Web server and local computing power are already available
- [OpenAI Whisper](#) is a free model for **speech recognition**
 - can be used on your own hardware
 - but requires a **NVIDIA** graphics card
 - with [whisper.cpp](#) there is a fork with **CPU** support
 - requires ~**1.5 times** the episode length on my hardware

- There are numerous hosting offers with fair prices
- In principle, however, a simple web server will do the trick
 - Feeds can also be created with tools like [Hugo](#)
 - There are also plugins for common **CMS** such as WordPress
- I came across [Castopod](#) in the Fediverse
 - successfully **generdsniped** the regional Mastodon instance operator
 - first podcast on [podcasts.darmstadt.social](#) 🎉

Castopod

- Open source platform for podcast hosting
- Easy to use WebUI
- supports **ActivityPub**
 - Can be subscribed to directly from Mastodon and co.
 - Community interaction
- numerous **additional functions**
 - themes
 - SEO, monetization



- developed in **PHP**
- can also be hosted via **Docker** or Podman
- Nasty **pitfall**: missing `range-requests` support in the pre-built container image
 - absolutely required by **Apple Podcasts** for episode streams
 - Troubleshooting despite great help was not trivial
 - Lessons learned: Validate feed URL

- An account on podcasts.social is mandatory!
 - Posts for **episodes**, but also direct community **interaction**
 - Best Practice: **Pin** current episode to profile
 - Build a **bubble**: Track **hashtags**, participate in **conversations**
- Enter the feed in databases such as [fyyd](https://fyyd.com)
 - there are often special interest projects, such as [wisspod](https://wisspod.com)
- Participate in other **communities** (e.g. thinkpad-forum.de)
- Attend conferences like this one (duh!)
 - People love **stickers** ✨
- **Collaborations** with friendly podcasts

- Self-hosted [Matomo](#) for the **website** (clicks/sources)
- [Mastometrics](#) for Mastodon** interactions**
- [OP3](#) (**O**pen **P**odcast **P**refix **P**roject) for **episode** downloads
 - Client information about redirects, requires feed customization

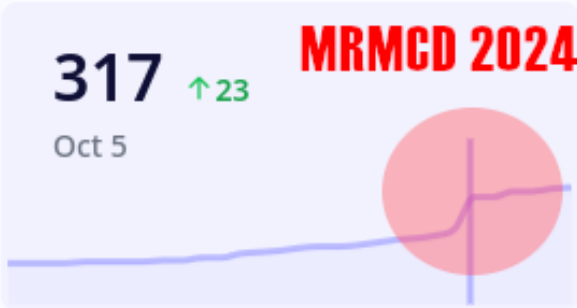

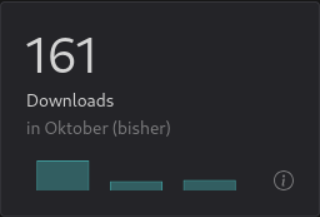

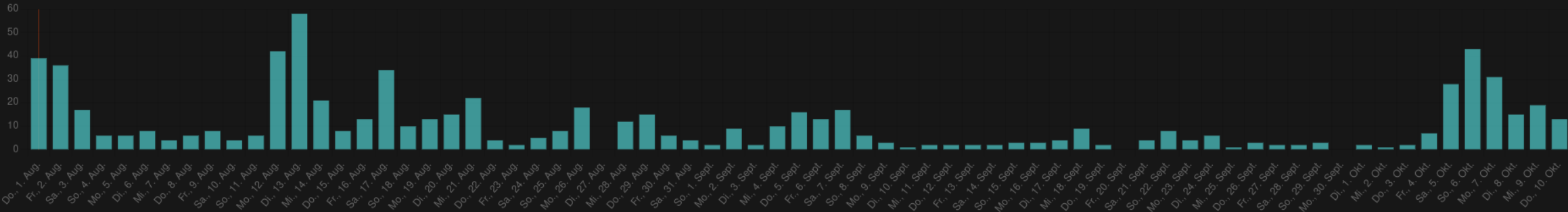

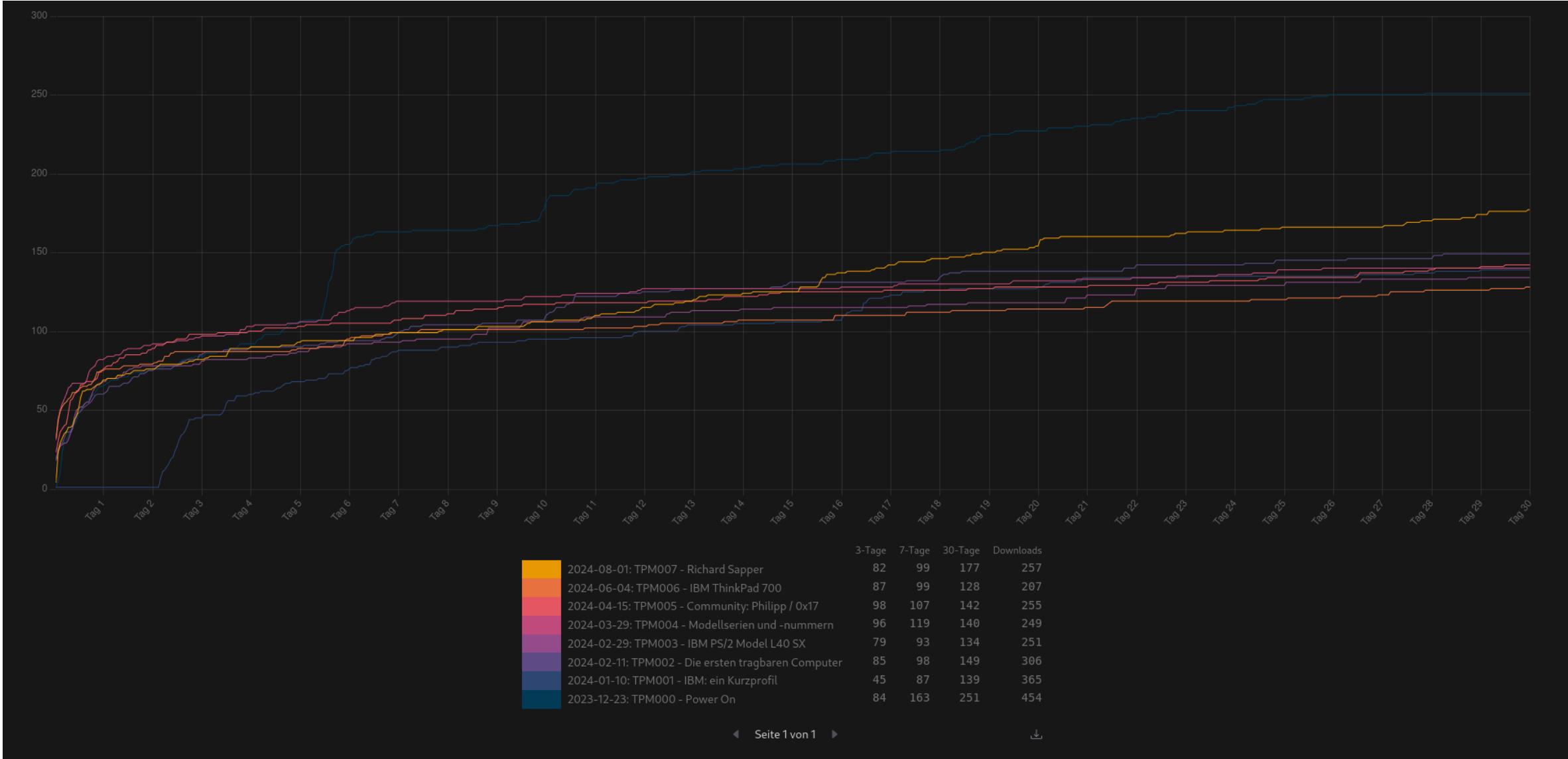
Wie OP3 Downloads berechnet →
